#### **Dear Parents**

Below are further details of the fees and admissions arrangements for Frenchay Out Of School Club.

We require a £10 registration fee per child on registration which may be paid by Paypal online at <a href="https://www.oosc.co.uk/registration">www.oosc.co.uk/registration</a>. We also require a completed online <a href="https://www.oosc.co.uk/registration">Child Registration Form</a> per child to provide us with the information we are required to keep on the premises whilst children attend the club as well as a signed <a href="https://www.oosc.co.uk">Parent Contract</a>. **Opening hours:** Term Time Only

Breakfast Club Monday to Friday **7:45am to 8:50am** (Breakfast is served until 8.30am)

After School Club Monday to Thursday 3:30pm to 6:00pm

Children may be collected from the After School Club at any time before 6:00pm but please be aware that collection after 6:00pm will incur a £3.00 fine per child, increasing by £3 every 5 minutes.

#### Fees:

Parents of **pre-booked**, **regular users** will be charged per month over **11 months** (as below) **Please reference your payments with your customer reference number starting with the 4-digit club code FRCH** 

Occasional / additional bookings: £10.75 after school / £6 breakfast club subject to availability Emergency, Same-day bookings (after school) subject to availability: £12.50 (no reductions) Holiday Club £26.00 8am-6pm St Helens School, Alveston

For regular use we operate a **11-monthly payment schedule September 2020 to July 2021**, based on the annual 190 teaching days per year. For ease of payment, fees are averaged out over 11 months and are due in advance by **the 7th of each month**, and calculated based on the number of sessions attending per week: **Fees are payable from 1**st **September to guarantee places**.

Regular User fees are paid by setting up a **11 month** Standing Order or by Childcare Voucher transfer. Childcare vouchers are a tax-free way to pay, and we are registered to accept several different voucher providers including the Government Tax Free scheme. Speak to your employer and save money on your fees. Payment is to be made by 7<sup>th</sup> of each month or a 10% fine added. For Occasional or Additional use (not the same days every week, or not every week) please book online by Paypal or advance childcare voucher transfer. These are bookable up to 10pm the day before the session, subject to availability. For Emergency same-day bookings (subject to availability), please email <a href="mailto:admin@oosc.co.uk">admin@oosc.co.uk</a> or phone the contact numbers below. Payment is to be made by BACS only (OOSC xxxxxxx97 xx-xx-32). Please see our Terms and Conditions and our Admissions and Fees Policy for further details of fee-paying.

#### **Please be aware of the following:** As stated in our Fees policy –

- 1. Cancellations, absence through illness and holidays taken in term time are to be paid for.
- 2. All occasional or additional booked sessions are to be paid for in advance.
- 3. A calendar months' notice is required for alterations and cancellation of a regular booking.

## Usual Arrangements for child arrival at Breakfast Club (currently subject to change):

From 7:45am please ring the doorbell on the school gate to gain access to the club in the school hall. Please register your child on arrival. Children will have a range of activities available to enjoy, indoors and outdoors. From 7:45am to 8:30am children will be served a breakfast of cereals, toast, fruit and fruit juice. This is included in the session fee. Please let us know if your children have already had breakfast and any specific dietary requirements should be outlined on the Admissions Form. At the beginning of the school day, children will be escorted to their classrooms. Please note there is no access to the classrooms at the beginning of the day. If you have a message for your child's teacher, please pass this to club staff to pass on. Our club mobile number for use during club hours is 07935754355.

#### Arrangements for child arrival at After School Club (currently subject to change):

At the end of the school day, children attending the club in Key Stage 1 will wait in the classroom where they will be met by club staff and escorted to the hall and registered on arrival. Key Stage 2 children will make their own way to the club. If your child appears distressed or we have any concerns about their attendance we will contact you. Please ensure that your child's class teacher and your child are aware that they will be attending the club. From 3:30-4:30pm children will be served a light snack such as toast, fruit and drinks. This is included in the session fee. Any specific dietary requirements should be outlined on the Admissions Form.

## Usual Arrangements for child collection from After School club (currently subject to change):

Children are collected from the hall via the side entrance door. Please ring the buzzer on the playground gate and a member of staff will let you in. You will need to sign your child(ren) out. Our club mobile number, for use during club hours is **07935754355**.

Please note there is no access to the classrooms at this time. If you have a message for your child's teacher please pass this to club staff to pass on.

## Illness:

Please be aware that children will not be accepted at the club if they are ill. If a child arrives at the club and is suffering from sickness, diarrhoea or has an infectious condition, parents will be notified immediately to collect their child. In line with the South Gloucestershire Schools' policy we cannot accept children at the club within 48 hours of sickness or diarrhoea. We cannot administer any medication without consent. If you wish us to administer prescribed medication please ask for an *Administering Medication form* which you will need to complete and return to us at the club with the clearly labelled medication. All medication will be stored out of reach and only administered by a qualified first aider.

# Coronavirus update at July 2020:

OOSC follow the current government guidance for out of school clubs. Children regularly wash their hands on arrival, before and after they eat and before leaving the club. Parents and carers must remain off-site as much as possible.
